



MISSION TO CHINA, 2010

Day 1 - 10/21 Los Angeles/Beijing

Self-travel to Los Angeles International Airport for an afternoon flight, MU586, at 12:30 PM to Beijing. Your adventure begins as you fly trans-Pacific aboard a wide cabin jetliner. Cross the International Dateline.

Day 2 - 10/22 Beijing

Arrive in Beijing, the Capital of China at 11:00 PM after a stopover in Shanghai. You will be met by your local tour guide at the airport. Transfer to the hotel.

Day 3 - 10/23 Beijing

Visit Tiananmen Square, the largest square in the world, and the Temple of Heaven, built in AD 1420, where the emperors prayed to heaven for a good harvest. Sightseeing includes the Palace Museum, also known as the Forbidden City, home of 24 emperors with a total of 9,999 rooms, and the Summer Palace, known for many significant features such as the Long Corridor with painted gallery, Kunming Lake and Longevity Hill, Seventeen-Arch Bridge and Marble Boat.

Day 4 - 10/24 Beijing

Tour bus excursion to the Great Wall, the 4,000- mile long, 2,000 year old construction is said to be the only man-made structure visible by the naked eye from the moon. Visit to the Ming Tombs, one of 13 Ming Emperors' Tombs, is fully excavated and open for exploration. In the evening, enjoy a Roasted Beijing Duck dinner.

Day 5 - 10/25 Beijing/Shanghai/Suzhou

Morning China Eastern flight, MU583, 11:10 AM to Shanghai, then take the tour bus trip to Suzhou. Afternoon sightseeing to the centuries old Linger Garden, Tiger Hill and Hanshan Temple. Visit the National Embroidery Institute to see silk embroidery, an important local craft with a 1,000 year history. Evening Dinner Show of traditional Chinese Music.

Day 6 - 10/26 Suzhou/Hangzhou

Morning tour bus journey to Hangzhou. Visit to Economic Development Zone. Visit to the centuries old Lingyin Temple, with the main feature of a 64.3 ft-high camphor-wood carved Buddha.



Day 7 - 10/27 Hangzhou/Shanghai

Morning boat cruise on West Lake with a relaxing stopover at jewel-like pagodas and tea houses. Afternoon tour bus trip to Shanghai.

Day 8 - 10/28 Shanghai

Sightseeing includes the Yu Garden, a maze of marvelous pavilions, ponds, rocky works and over arching trees. Visit to the Bund, a famous waterfront park. Visit the Pudong Economic Development Zone.

Day 9 - 10/29 Shanghai/Los Angeles

You may spend your final hours in China on your own in the morning. Afternoon flight, MU583, will depart by 2:50 PM for Los Angeles where you will arrive at 10:30 AM on the same day.

OPTIONAL SIDE TRIP TO XI'AN, TRIP 2010

We designed this optional trip to Xi'an mainly for those who are traveling to China for the second time, and have already visited Suzhou and Hangzhou during their first visit.

Day 1-Day 4: The same itinerary as above.

Day 5: Morning flight to Xi'an, stay at Grand Castle Hotel. Afternoon sightseeing to the Big Wild Geese Pagoda. Evening entertainment of Tang Style Dancing.

Day 6: Morning bus excurses to the Terra-Cotta Warriors at the Tomb of the First Emperor of Qin Dynasty. On the way back, visit the Huaqing Hot Spring Park and Banpo Museum, a preserved pre-historic cavemen site.

Day 7-Day 9: Flight to Shanghai, then the same itinerary like everybody else.

Additional Price: The additional cost is \$450 USD /per person, in addition to the tour fare of the regular itinerary. The single room supplement is the same as the regular trip.

Special Note: The Chamber will assign the passengers to separate buses for the regular itinerary and side trip itinerary. The passengers with different itineraries are on different buses for whole trip. On the basis of group travel, you have to get at least 10 passengers to start a regular trip or a side trip bus.
