**SEDONA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE ANNOUNCES NOMINATING COMMITTEE
FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION**

Linda Goldenstein, Chairman of the Board of the Sedona Chamber of Commerce (SCC) has announced the Nominating Committee for the 2011 Board of Directors election. This year's committee will consist of the following board members: Linda Goldenstien, Chairman; Armor Todd, Vice Chairman; Carol Golden, Sedona Elegant Events; Mal Wienges, Sedona Broadcasting; Wendy Lippman, Tlaquepaque Arts & Crafts Village; and Jennifer Wesselhoff President/CEO of the Sedona Chamber of Commerce.

For those members in good standing, with an interest to serve, please stop by the Chamber's administrative office located at 45 Sunset Drive and complete the Board Nomination Request Form which must be submitted no later than **August 20, 2010**. The nomination request form is also available on www.SedonaChamber.com under About the Chamber click on the Board of Director's page. The nominating committee is charged with selecting a slate of candidates to present to the general membership through an annual election. Candidates will contend for 6 vacant seats, each for a three (3) year term.

Should a nominated member not be included on the slate, the chamber member may self-nominate for the Sedona Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors by submitting a petition bearing the signatures of 5% (approximately 50) of the qualified chamber membership. (Multiple persons from the same firm do not constitute qualified chamber members.) Interested parties may obtain petitions at the chamber's business office. Completed petitions must be delivered to the

business office or mailed to PO Box 478, Sedona, AZ 86339, no later than 5:00 PM on September 17, 2010.

A ballot will be mailed to every chamber member in good standing on September 22, 2010 and members are encouraged to vote. Votes must be received by October 11, 2010 at 5 PM. The votes are received in sealed envelopes, stamped with the date received and held for counting.

On October 12, 2010 at least three (3) but not more than five (5) judges who are not members of the Board of Directors or candidates for election will count the ballots. These Judges will be appointed by the Chairman of the Board and they will have complete supervision over the election, including the auditing of the ballots. The judges will report the results of the election to the Board of Directors and elected candidates will be notified immediately by the Chairman of the Board who also sends a written notification to those who were not elected.

This is an open process that offers interested Chamber members the opportunity to volunteer their time and efforts to enhance Sedona's business environment.
