Day 02 - Feb 06th Sunday: Arrival to Cairo city

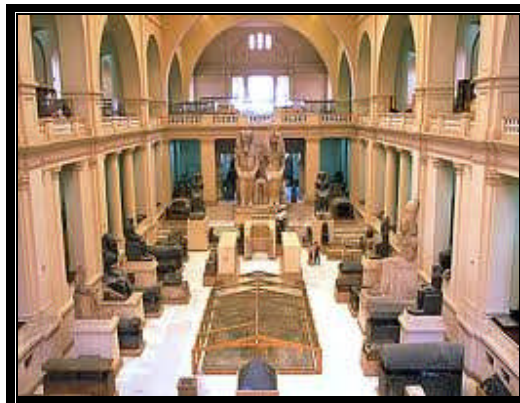
Arrive at Cairo airport, met by your Quest Travel tour manager. Transfer to Le Meriden Pyramids Hotel

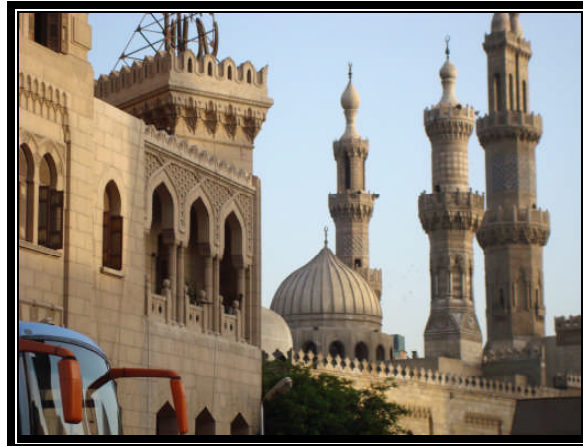

It is a must that all passport holders of the following nationalities obtain their own visas from Egyptian Embassy or Consulate located in his or her own country prior to arrival in Egypt:

Arab countries:

Palestine, Tunisia, Morocco, Algeria, Iraq, Sudan, Somali, Mauritania

Europe:

Bosnia, Russia, Moldavia, Armenia, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Azerbaijan, Kosovo

Asia:

Turkey, China, Afghanistan, Philippine, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Pakistan, India, Indonesia, Iran, Israel, Vietnam

Africa:

All African countries

Payment:
